Welcome to the Nevada Northern Railway National Historic Landmark. The motto of the Nevada Northern is **"Safety First"**. Please review and adhere to the following safety rules.

- As you get on and off the train, **always face the train!** That way if you fall, you'll have padding to fall on and not your **face**. Maintain a three-point contact when you are getting off and on cars. Hand your bulky equipment to a crewmember or friend as you get on and off.
- If you don't understand what is happening, ask for clarification from a train crew member.
- Always stay at least **25 feet** from any piece of rail equipment when you cross the track. You never know when a piece of equipment may move.
- Never cross the track between equipment (locomotives, rail cars) unless there is **50 feet** separation between the equipment.
- **Never** stand or walk between the rails and always stand at least **6 feet** from the track.
- As you cross a track - look both ways.
- Do not step on the railhead, **always** step over the rail.
- Never climb on a piece of equipment until you receive permission from a crew member.
- Most of the times we will be getting on and off from one side of the train. This will allow the train crew to keep everyone in sight as they give movement orders to the engineer. If you have forgotten something on the train ask a train crewmember if it is safe for you to go back on the equipment.
- If you elect not to get off at a particular photo location, you're welcome to stay on the train. **But you will need to stay on the train until the next photo location.**
- Watch where you position yourself in the photo line; be aware of your surroundings and fellow photographers at all times, be courteous.
- Some photographers will be shooting video; please don't talk when they are shooting.
- Be aware of hot surfaces such as the caboose stove.
- Dress warmly! Dress in layers. Wear boots. We will be out on the line for hours at a time.
- Restroom facilities may only available at the depot, plan accordingly.
- Please wear your blue badges on the outside of your coat. This will serve as your ticket to participate in the photo shoot. People without badges will be asked to leave.
- The engine house opens about 5:00a. Some of the best photographs have been taken there, your badge gives you access at any time.
- Watch where you go! There are tripping hazards, loose rocks and open pits, **pay attention!**
