History Channel's "American Restorations" Features Nevada Northern Railway

Ely, NV--- Nevada Northern Railway's wig wag signals will be featured on the hit show, "American Restorations," tomorrow, Tues., April 16th. The show will air at 10:30 p.m./9:30 p.m. central time. Check local listing for exact time. The wig-wag signal was restored by Rick's Restoration in Las Vegas. It is the sixth artifact to be restored by Rick's and the sixth Nevada Northern Railway episode on the television show.

The wig-wag signal, along with the other restored artifacts, will be the highlight of Restoration Rails, the new steam dinner train featured at Nevada Northern Railway this year. The first Restoration Rails Steam Train will debut on Sat., June 22 at 6:30 p.m. and feature a simple dinner and behind-the-scenes tour of the artifacts, along with narration on the train by Nevada Northern Executive Director, Mark Bassett.

Open daily, except Tuesdays; the Museum is located at 1100 Avenue A in Ely, Nevada. Visitors are invited to explore the Nevada Northern Railway Museum. It consists of a fifty-six acre complex, with sixty-six historic structures, that is recognized as a National Historic Landmark. Starting April 13, the Museum offers steam- and diesel-powered passenger train excursions. The first dinner train of the season is the Rockin' & Rollin' Geology Train on May 18th; followed by the Wild West Train on May 25th. This year's dinner trains will all be steam.

For the ultimate rail fan experience, the BE the Engineer program allows one or two individuals to rent a steam and/or diesel locomotive and operate the locomotives out on the mainline track – even with the train (freight cars attached). Cab Rides with the Engineer are also available (limit two per train ride).
