Position Overview

The Nevada Northern Railway Museum is seeking a dynamic individual to support and lead interpretive programming on our astro-tourism trains: the **Great Basin Star Train** and the **Sunset, Stars & Champagne Train**. Our renowned Star Train was featured on *CBS This Morning*: [Watch Here](#).

This role includes public engagement with astronomy programming, enforcing safety protocols, guiding telescope use, and interpreting the night sky for diverse audiences. Additionally, the position involves providing historical interpretation of our National Historic Landmark, including conducting guided tours and participating in train operations (brakeman, conductor, fireman, or engineer).

Supervision

Reports to the Superintendent and/or Trainmaster.

Key Responsibilities

- Lead public astronomy programs on specialty trains, connecting visitors to the night sky.
 - Ensure safety procedures are followed and assist guests in using telescopes.
 - Assist with and help improve astronomy-related programming and events.
 - Conduct guided tours of the Nevada Northern Railway National Historic Landmark (approximately 60 minutes in length).
 - Participate in train operations, including roles such as steam or diesel engineer, fireman, brakeman, or conductor (training provided).
 - Represent the museum professionally during public interactions and special programs.

Work Environment & Physical Requirements

- The work takes place at 6,500 ft elevation in Ely, Nevada—a remote, high-desert location with temperature extremes (-30°F to 90°F).
 - Closest major cities with air service are Salt Lake City and Las Vegas (both 240 miles away).
 - Must be able to lift 60-pound telescopes safely.
 - Requires extended periods of standing, walking, lifting, and working outdoors at night.
 - Involves physical labor, exposure to seasonal weather, and interaction with mechanical and rail equipment.
 - Ely offers essential amenities including grocery stores, restaurants, lodging, a hospital, and a DMV.
